### Scholarship Guidelines for The Jeffrey and Lynette Woda Scholarship

November 5, 2019

The Jeffrey and Lynette Woda Scholarship (the “Scholarship”) shall be for four continuous school years. The Scholarship shall be in the amount of \$22,000 per school year, four years or \$88,000, for Bethany College ([www.bethanywv.edu](http://www.bethanywv.edu)) in Bethany, WV. Eligible applicants must be a current senior student and an occupant in a Woda Cooper housing community for at least 90 days in good standing. Applicant must be a student in good standing, must be enrolled in the pre-college curriculum, and must be on track to graduate the end of the current school year.

#### Eligibility:

1. Interested applicants must submit an application and all related attachments on or before March 1st. Applicants will be advised if they have been awarded the scholarship no later than April 15th.
2. Applicants are expected to graduate from high school in the spring of the year of application.
3. Applicants must be planning to attend Bethany College on a full-time basis and plan to pursue a bachelor’s degree and must reside in college owned housing.
4. Applicants must have an accumulated 3.2 grade point average at time of application over the past 4 years.
5. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen with no criminal history. Should a recipient of the Scholarship be convicted of a crime (other than a minor traffic violation), or be expelled from a school, all future Scholarship payments shall be immediately terminated.

Application – An applicant must submit, at a minimum, the items listed on the Scholarship Opportunity Outline.

#### **Maintenance of Scholarship:**

Once a recipient receives an award, no additional annual application will be necessary. Recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA at the end of each academic year in order to remain eligible for the scholarship.

Funds can be used for tuition, room and board, and will be submitted directly to Bethany College bursar office on a semi-annual basis. It is expected that the recipient will attend school on a regular full-time basis year to year for four years. Any gap in attendance may cause the loss of the Scholarship.

#### Awarding of Funds:

1. If awarded, the student will be required to sign an award agreement which outlines the conditions of the scholarship including academic performance expectations while a Bethany College student.
2. Bethany College personnel will review all applications and award the Scholarship.
